TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility

Hardship Grants are available to UK residents only. To be eligible for a hardship grant, the following criteria must be met:

- Patient must have a diagnosed immunodeficiency
- Must be a UK resident

What we fund:

- The cost of prescriptions
- Travel to hospital
- Access to care

Grants are for a one-time payment of £100 only.

Applications can only be made by a recognised medical professional on the patient's behalf. Details given must be accurate.

All the information given will be treated confidentially.

The Hardship Grants will take up to 7 working days to process and up to a further 30 days to arrive in the patient's bank account.

Only the referring medical professional should complete the form.
